Sub: Violations of 'Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act' [COTPA 2003]

Under COTPA 2003, there is a provision of penalty up to Rs. 200=00 on smoking at public places. However, if anyone is found smoking in public places and refuses to pay the fine imposed by the competent authority, the person will have to be produced before the Court as a non-FIR case.

In order that the provisions of penalty is implemented properly in Kolkata Metropolitan Area and adjoining areas immediately, it is, therefore, requested that a Judicial Magistrate having appropriate authority and jurisdiction may please be assigned the work pertaining to the above-mentioned Act.

This may please be treated as urgent since Kolkata Police and other competent authorities will also have to be informed about this assignment.
